

Materials List *for small statues*

All supplies should be blessed according to the statue filling book and then not used for any other purpose.

Cleaning:

hammer
long screwdrivers
scrapers
needle nose pliers
wire brushes
flashlights
khatags
cotton

Sealing:

magic sculpt
Jesmonite resin
rubber gloves
small container
brush
hair dryer
Dremel tool
saffron
metal shears

Rolling:

hammer
incense
tape
crate paper
paper cutter
printer
statue book with disk
pen

Filling:

lavender
camphor
jewels/precious stones
bodhi leaves
Guru's hair
nectar pill
life pill
blessed sindhura
tsa-tsa statues
crystals or stones with Sanskrit letters
small Dharma texts
small statues
chopsticks or skewers
long pliers

Finishing:

epoxy glue
felt
Elmer's glue
paint brushes
metal colored paint
X-ACTO knife
wooden stick
cardboard

Materials List *for large statues*

All items will be supplied and blessed by the community with Offering to the Spiritual Guide puja.

Central Channel:

wood peice
gold paint
gold thread
kusha grass
couch grass roots
mantras rolled into appropriate size and wrapped with correct color tissue paper (white, red, blue, yellow, gold, green)
cloth to cover

Heart Packet:

Geshe-la's hair
bodhi leaves
blessed sindhura
long-life pills

Treasure Vase:

precious metals
precious/semi-precious stones
malas
jewelry

Filling:

bags sewn from new gold colored cotton, like those used for robes
rose petals
camphor
lavendar
cedar
large cloth for bottom

Lotus Mantras:

these mantras should be rolled into 50 slip rolls and wrapped with yellow tissue paper then stacked tightly into clean cardboard boxes
